ALL SECTIONS ARE TENTATIVE AND SUBJECT TO CHANGE

Classes scheduled Monday & Tuesday - 8:00 am to 12:30 pm

Clinicals scheduled for 6 weeks, 3 weeks in pediatrics and 3 weeks in maternal-infant settings.

16 hrs/wk generally two days/week starting @ 7^{am} [except as noted] plus one 4 hour independent community clinical¹; some rotations have evening shifts. Clinical orientation & skills labs are scheduled for Tuesday.

Plan for class every day 8-4:30 the first week of the course.

**Students must register for one section in Parent Child Nursing
and one in Mental Health Nursing.**

If you plan to take PCN first you register for NURS 219 3M... & NURS 221 3N... or vice versa,
if you want MH first register for NURS 221 3M... and NURS 219 3N....

PCN 'M' sections [1st 8 weeks] start Jan 19, 2010 at 8 am and

PCN 'N' [2nd 8 weeks] start Mar 15, 2010 at 8 am in Room 421

Notes:

1. Students who score <850 on the NAC 1 **mid-curricular exam** must complete the remediation prior to August 9 at 2 pm to keep their section.
2. **Current TB, CPR & Liability insurance** [good for the semester] is due by June 28, 2010
TB is due to the Joan Hodge, RN, MN, in Room 619 by June 28, 2010
CPR & Liability is due to Ms. Givens in Room 603A by June 28, 2010
Liability insurance is typically good for one year only so all students who started in Basics Fall 2009 will need to renew their insurance.
Documentation of current TB, CPR, & Liability insurance good for the Fall 2010 semester
Must be in the designated offices prior to June 28, 2010 to keep their section.
3. Information about the textbook, skills required, and suggested readings for the first week of class is in the '**Welcome Letter**' published on the DCC CSN web site [enrolled students] and on the course blackboard site. Email requests for enrollment in the course blackboard site to Dr Steele at nsteel@dcc.edu. The site will open July 1, 2010.
3. Students must register for a section even if it one they do not want, to be sure of a space in the Fall course. Requests for changes can be submitted to Dr Steele [nsteel@dcc.edu] and will be honored for sections available on a first come first serve basis based on the date/time of the email. Names of students in each section will be posted on the course blackboard site to aid students in arranging for one-to-one switches.
4. Students who do not get a section must email Dr. Steele [nsteel@dcc.edu] to be notified if and when spaces do become available
