

**DELGADO COMMUNITY COLLEGE TUITION & FEES SCHEDULES
FALL 2010 SEMESTER**

Louisiana House Bill 734, which became law as Act 915 on June 14, 2008, authorizes state colleges and universities to increase their tuitions by 3 – 5% at a time. Under this law, the Louisiana Community and Technical College System (LCTCS) Board of Supervisors – the governing body of Delgado Community College – approved a tuition increase in 2009-2010, and a second in 2010-2011.

As well, in March 2010, the LCTCS Board of Supervisors approved that system colleges assess a \$16 fee for all students per semester, which will be dedicated to upgrading and improving the student information system. In accordance with this law and LCTCS approval, both Delgado’s resident and non-resident tuition will increase, and certain student fees will increase, beginning in fall 2010.

Therefore, new, transfer and re-admit students of the former LTC Region 1/ Technical Division will pay Delgado Community College’s increased tuition rate beginning in fall 2010 semester (see tuition schedule below).

There will be an exception, however, for **continuing** students of the former LTC Region 1. For the remaining classes needed to complete the program in which they were enrolled as of spring 2010 semester, **continuing students** will pay the LTC Region 1 tuition rate that was in effect before the merger.

The chart below provides the Delgado tuition rates effective fall 2010 for resident and non-resident students, which includes the tuition increases*.

- One academic year - \$50
- Fall or Spring only - \$30
- Summer session only - \$20
- Additional vehicles
 - Faculty staff – no fee for second vehicle; \$20 each subsequent vehicle
 - Students – \$10 each vehicle
- Adjunct Faculty – no fee for one semester; \$10 each additional vehicle
- Adjunct Faculty, consecutive semesters - \$30 each semester
- Non-credit students, one semester - \$15
- Temporary & One Day Permits – No fee
