

Estimated Costs for Delgado Community College Pharmacy Technician Program

Tuition and Fees:

Pharmacy Technician students pay the same tuition and fees each term as other credit students enrolled in the college.

<p>Uniform / shoes \$ 150</p>	<p>Students must have full uniform by 1st day of class or they will be not be admitted to class</p> <p>Please note – you will need to order monogrammed shirts approximately 3 weeks before the start of the semester for them to be ready for the first day of class</p>
<p>Textbooks \$ 945*</p>	<p>Semester 1 – Textbooks are approximately \$710 (new)</p> <p>Semester 2 – Textbooks are approximately \$108 (new) - *Sterile Products registration fee \$125, due on 1st day of class to program director</p> <p>Semester 3 – Textbooks are approximately \$126.60 (new)</p>
<p>Health Screening \$200</p>	<p>Students are required to complete a drug screen within 2 weeks of program orientation (\$25)</p> <p>Students are required to have a complete physical examination including negative TB test, Hepatitis B positive titer, positive titers** for MMR¹. Proof of physical exam and other health requirements must be completed prior to the first day of class</p> <p>Students attending clinicals Oct - Apr must have a Flu vaccine by Sept 1</p> <p>* Delgado does NOT provide health screening ** Vaccination records are not sufficient to meet affiliate requirements – student must have positive titers. If Student has a negative titer, they must be re-vaccinated.</p>
<p>Louisiana Board of Pharmacy (LABP) \$150 www.labp.com</p>	<p>Students will submit an application for Technician Candidate status at the start of the their second semester.</p> <p>Application Fee \$25 (check or money order) Notary Fee \$ 0 - \$20 (approx.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student's may be required to provide legal documentation which may require additional funding from the agency supplying the documents; ie. Social security card, legal name change, court documents • The LABP requires a background check to be completed once they receive the application. The fingerprint packet will be sent by the LABP, the student will receive this approximately 2 weeks after submitting LABP application to the program director. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Background check approx. \$45 (money order or certified check) ○ Finger print cards (2)* \$ 10 - \$30 <p>Do NOT get a background check done before instructed to do so by the program director – ONLY LABP documents will be accepted.</p>
<p>PTCE \$129 www.ptcb.org</p>	<p>Pharmacy Technician Certification Exam: Students are required to register for the PTCEB at Mid-Term of the 3rd (last) Semester</p>

¹ Students meeting qualifications that are selected are accepted conditionally on completing Drug screen and passing a Physician's examination. All students are required to have the Hepatitis B vaccine, a negative TB test, and positive titers for Measles, Mumps, Rubella and Varicella.

In addition to the related program expenses, students will have expenses related to completing requirements for the LABP to become a Pharmacy Technician. Completion of these items has no bearing on program completion. The following 2 expenses could be incurred 1 - 12 months post-program
