

## Fall 2019 Students - Registration Information NURS 113: Nursing I and NURS 117: Pharmacology I

Dear Students:

Welcome to Charity School of Nursing (CSN) and Nursing I!! Your first semester of nursing school is finally here. It is something that you have been working hard to achieve as you have taken your prerequisites. The Nursing I faculty and the course coordinator want to welcome you to the school and our course. You may be feeling a little apprehension mixed with excitement, and these are normal feelings. In a few short weeks, these feelings will be forgotten as you are challenged to learn a new method of thinking about caring, new skills required of nurses to provide quality patient-centered care and of course, the foundation for your nursing career. In two short years, you will join professional nurses across the country in a profession that is challenging and respected worldwide.

Registration for NURS 113 and NURS 117 students is **Wednesday, May 22, 2019 at 10:00 am.**

Before registering on LoLA, you need to check the registration information posted on the CSN website. You will need to know the time and location of your clinical sites before you register. After registering, it is extremely important to secure your enrollment by paying tuition/making down payment/ensuring that financial aid is in order before the College deadline. **If you do not get the desired clinical section/site, please do not call or email to be added to the section. To change sections after you have registered, you must find another nursing student to switch with you.**

Mandatory new student and course orientation is **Wednesday, August 7, 2019 from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm and Thursday, August 8, 2019 from 8:00 am to 4:30pm** at Charity School of Nursing. Registration is on the first floor, and you must sign in. **Attendance at New Student Orientation is mandatory for both days. Students who do not attend will not be able to begin the program until the following semester (Spring 2020).** The first day of clinical orientation is tentatively set to begin **Saturday, August 17, 2019** for all Level I Saturday clinical groups (**see schedule below for day/ evening and Saturday clinical rotations**). Both Pharmacology I and Nursing I classes are held in the Charity School of Nursing building at 450 S. Claiborne Avenue on Thursdays and Fridays during the spring semester.

Each nursing section is limited to 8 students. **Please do not make work or childcare arrangements until after you have registered for the course.**

**You must ensure that the following requirements are met to register for nursing courses. Pay close attention to the items below:**

1. **TB testing, background check, drug test, health records, CPR and professional liability insurance** should be uploaded to your CastleBranch account by **Friday, June 7, 2019:**
  - a. Do not call to notify that the information is uploaded into CastleBranch.
  - b. *CPR, TB, and liability insurance must be **valid through the entire semester.***
2. **Personal health insurance:** It is recommended that students have their own health insurance.
3. **Name changes:** Current Delgado students: If you have had a name change and your name is different than what appears in Canvas or the e-mail system, please e-mail the course coordinator at [rsalas@dcc.edu](mailto:rsalas@dcc.edu) with the name that does appear in Canvas or e-mail. 4. **Clinical Schedule:** The clinical rotation schedule posted on the CSN website is **a tentative schedule and is subject to change**. You will be required to have your uniform, stethoscope, watch and BP cuff the first week of school, **Saturday, August 17, 2019 (Saturday groups) and Tuesday, August 20, 2019 (day/evening groups and/or 12-hour week day groups)**. Please be sure that your lab coat is  $\frac{3}{4}$  length or full length. Your clinical rotation starts at Charity School of Nursing according to the following schedule:

The first four weeks of the clinical rotation will be at Charity School of Nursing. Your clinical instructor will inform you when to report to your clinical site.

**The following is the tentative nursing clinical experience (NEX) schedule or the first six (6) weeks of the semester:** (All clinical groups will be at Charity School of Nursing (CSN) weeks 1 through 4 according the following schedule.

1. **Week # 1 – Saturday, August 17, 2019; Tuesday, August 20, 2019 and Wednesday, August 21, 2019:**
  - a. **7:00 AM – 7:00 PM All Saturday 12-hour clinical group (s)**
  - b. **7:30 AM – 1:30 PM All Tuesday and Wednesday day clinical group (s)**
  - c. **7:30 AM – 7:30 PM All Tuesday 12-hour clinical group (s)**
  - d. **7:30 AM – 7:30 PM All Wednesday 12-hour clinical group (s)**
  - e. **3:00 PM – 9:00 PM All Tuesday and Wednesday evening clinical group (s)**
2. **Week # 2 - Saturday, August 24, 2019; Tuesday, August 27, 2019 and Wednesday, August 28, 2019: Follow week # 1 schedule.**
3. **Week # 3 - Saturday, August 31, 2019; Tuesday, September 3, 2019 and Wednesday, September 4, 2019: Follow week # 2 schedule.**
4. **Week # 4 - Saturday, September 7, 2019; Tuesday, September 10, 2019 and Wednesday, September 11, 2019: Follow week # 3 schedule.**
5. **Week # 5, # 6, & # 7** The nursing clinical experience (NEX) begins. Students will begin clinical rotations in the nursing home and continue with the clinical skills labs at Charity School of Nursing.
6. **Week # 8** The NEX hospital clinical rotation begins. Students will begin clinical rotations in the hospital settings and continue with the clinical skills labs at Charity School of Nursing.

The Nursing I faculty and the course coordinator look forward to meeting you and teaching you in your exciting, first semester of nursing school. Welcome to Delgado Community College Charity School of Nursing!
