

Fall 2018 Students - Registration Information NURS 113: Nursing I and NURS 117: Pharmacology I

Dear Students:

Welcome to Charity School of Nursing (CSN) and Nursing I!! Your first semester of nursing school is finally here. It is something that you have been working hard to achieve as you have taken your prerequisites. The Nursing I faculty and the course coordinator want to welcome you to the school and our course. You may be feeling a little apprehension mixed with excitement, and these are normal feelings. In a few short weeks, these feelings will be forgotten as you are challenged to learn a new method of thinking about caring, new skills required of nurses to provide quality patient-centered care and of course, the foundation for your nursing career. In two short years, you will join professional nurses across the country in a profession that is challenging and respected world-wide.

School orientation is **Wednesday, July 25, 2018 from 0830 to 1630 and Thursday, July 26, 2018 from 0830 to 1500** at Charity School of Nursing. Registration is on the first floor, and **you must sign in. Attendance at New Student Orientation is mandatory for both days. Students who do not attend will not be able to begin the program until the following semester (Spring 2019).** The first day of clinical orientation is tentatively set to begin **Saturday, August 18, 2018** for all Level I Saturday clinical groups (**see schedule below for day/ evening and Saturday clinical rotations**). Both Pharmacology I and Nursing I classes are held in the Charity School of Nursing building at 450 S. Claiborne Avenue on Thursdays and Fridays during the Fall semester.

Each nursing section is limited to 8 students. **Please do not make work or child care arrangements until after you have registered for the course.**

You must ensure that the following requirements are met to register for nursing courses. Pay close attention to the items below:

1. Registration for NURS 113 and NURS 117 students is **May 25, 2018 at 10:00AM.**
Before registering on LoLA, you need to check the registration information posted on the CSN website. You will need to know the time and location of your clinical sites before you register.
After registering, it is extremely important to secure your enrollment by paying tuition/making down payment/ensuring that financial aid is in order before the College deadline.
If you do not get the clinical site you want, please do not call or email to be added. To change sections after you have registered, you must find another nursing student to switch with you.
2. **TB testing and all needed health requirements, CPR, and student liability insurance** should be submitted to your CastleBranch account by **Friday, June 1, 2018:**
 - a. Do not call to notify that the information is uploaded into CastleBranch.
 - b. *CPR, TB, and liability insurance must be **valid through the entire semester.***
3. **Personal health insurance:** It is recommended that students have their own health insurance.
4. **Name changes:** Current Delgado students: If you have had a name change and your name is different than what appears in Canvas or the e-mail system, please e-mail the course coordinator at rsalas@dcc.edu with the name that does appear in Canvas or e-mail. 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5. **Clinical Schedule:** The clinical rotation schedule posted on the CSN website is **a tentative schedule and is subject to change**. You will be required to have your uniform, stethoscope, watch and BP cuff the first week of school, **Saturday, August 18, 2018 (Saturday groups) and Tuesday, August 21, 2018 (for day/evening groups and/or 12 hour week day groups)**. Please be sure that your lab coat is ¾ length or full length. The short white lab coats are for medical students.

Your clinical rotation starts at Charity School of Nursing according to the following schedule:

The first four weeks of the clinical rotation will be at Charity School of Nursing. Your clinical instructor will inform you when to report to your clinical site.

The following is the tentative nursing clinical schedule (NEX) for the first few weeks of the semester:

1. **Week # 1 – Saturday, August 18, 2018; Tuesday, August 21, 2018 and Wednesday, August 22 2018:**
All Saturday and day/ evening clinical groups will be at Charity School of Nursing (CSN)
 - a. **7:30 AM – 1:30 PM All day clinical groups**
 - b. **3:00 PM – 9:00 PM Evening clinical groups (*TBA by instructor)**
 - c. **Saturday: 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM (All Saturday clinical groups)**
2. **Week # 2 - Saturday, August 25, 2018, Tuesday, August 28, 2018 and Wednesday, August 29, 2018:**
Follow week # 1 schedule.
3. **Week # 3 – Saturday, September 1, 2018 and Wednesday, September 5, 2018:**
Follow week # 2 schedule.
4. **Week # 4 – Saturday, September 8, 2018, Tuesday, September 11, 2018 and Wednesday, September 12, 2018:**
Follow week # 3 schedule.
5. **Weeks # 5 through Week # 8:**
Students, one day a week, begin the nursing home experience and introduction to the geriatric population. This nursing clinical experience provides an opportunity for the student to perform basic nursing skills learned in the skills lab and begin to apply nursing practice and theory to patient care. Students will continue in the CSN skills lab one day a week.
6. **Week # 9: Hospital orientation and the nursing clinical experience (NEX) begins.** Patient assignments the day before the NEX and/or the day of the NEX is dependent on facility and clinical instructors' choice.

The Nursing I faculty and the course coordinator look forward to meeting you and teaching you in your exciting, first semester of nursing school. Welcome to Delgado Community College Charity School of Nursing!
