

**Check your LOLA preferred email account for messages about any changes over the Holiday break.**

The curriculum plan for the 2nd semester, Level II, includes five courses: NURS125 (Nursing II); NURS 129 (Special Populations I); NURS 127 (Pharmacology II); PSYC 127 (General Psychology); and BIOL 211 (Microbiology). All five must be completed before enrolling in the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester nursing courses. Students who enroll concurrently in NURS 125 (Nursing II) and NURS 129 (Special Populations I) must enroll in courses taught by the same faculty team: Such as Nursing Team 1 and Special Pops Team 1. Four teams are planned for spring 2019. Registration for Nursing 125 (Nursing II) is Thursday, December 13 at 1:30 pm; registration for NURS 129 (Special Populations) and NURS 127 (Pharmacology II) is Friday December 14 at 1:00 pm. Students must register for the section of Pharmacology II that correlates with Nursing II sections as indicated on the Pharmacology Table on page 4. **If you are Special Pops only please do not register for sections 311, 312, 313, 314, and 318. (Team 3). Students who register for section 311-314 and 318 will have the same clinical instructor for NURS 125 and NURS 129.** Register for the corresponding CRN numbers for NURS 125 and NURS 129. Follow the grid across. Students who have previously registered for a clinical nursing course must register for a different team/faculty member unless given permission to do so by the Level Coordinator. **Sections and Instructors subject to change after registration based on enrollment numbers.**

The clinical component of Nursing II is considered the ‘Home Base’ for enrolled students and students will rotate to the Special Populations I clinical which is generally scheduled for the same days, e.g. Wed/Thursday. Students who register for Nursing II sections 303, 309, & 317 will start their clinical in the Special Populations for the listed dates and rotate to the Nursing II clinical as their “Home Base” for the remainder of the semester. **Students who register in Nursing II sections 303, 309, & 317 please contact me via email ([cbrown5@dcc.edu](mailto:cbrown5@dcc.edu)) Monday, December 17** to select a Nursing II clinical section, these sections will be filled on a first email, first serve basis but not guaranteed. Use the following tables to register for corresponding sections of the nursing courses.

All students will be oriented to Level II on Tuesday January 22<sup>nd</sup> at 8:00 am at CSN, in the GYM if it is available. Plan to spend all **class & clinical** time at CSN 8am-3pm the first week of school (January 22<sup>nd</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>) even if you have evening or weekend clinical. Plan to wear class casual attire until you receive instructions from your clinical instructor. Sections will be available for students to drop/add until January 15 at 4 pm.

Students who plan to enroll **part time** may elect to enroll in a combination of courses with the understanding that there are pre and co-requisites that must be considered.

- NURS 127, **Pharmacology II** requires Nursing 113 and Pharm I as prerequisites.
- NURS 129, **Special Populations I** requires PSYC 127, General Psychology and NURS 127, Pharmacology II as a pre or co-requisites.
- NURS 125, **Nursing II** requires Pharm II as pre or co-requisite.

Notes:

1. A student repeating a clinical course will not be permitted to register for a section taught by any team or clinical instructor the student had when previously enrolled in that course unless given permission to do so by the level coordinator.
2. If there is no Special Populations I CRN that corresponds to the Nursing II CRN register for a CRN section in the same team.
3. Students enrolled in Special Populations I for the Spring may be contacted to discuss their scheduled time and/or location for Special Populations I because of ‘openings’ created by the students who previously completed Special Populations I.

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
