ABOUT

Delgado is licensed by the Louisiana Board of Barber Examiners (LBBE) to provide students with both theory and practical skills necessary to work efficiently in the industry of barber-styling. This program includes classroom instruction and practical/lab experience. Practical skills are developed through experience in an on-site barbershop which is equipped to industry standards and managed by the students with instructor supervision. Upon completion of this program, students will receive a Technical Diploma and are eligible to take the LA Board of Barber Examiners licensure exam.

PROGRAM ADMISSION

In addition to meeting all Delgado admission requirements, students must also meet the LBBE requirements. Before enrolling into any barbering courses, students must be issued a student license from the LA Board of Barber Examiners and attend a mandatory orientation session. In order for us to obtain your student license, you must submit the following items to the Sidney Collier Site:

- LA Board of Barber Examiners student application
- Birth certificate or driver's license*
- Social security card*
- Two photographs measuring approximately 2" x 2"
- \$90 money order
- Official High School Diploma or GED

**You must bring in the original documents. DCC staff will make a copy; we must be able to verify to the Board that we have seen the original documents.*
