## 1. Get admitted.

- Submit a complete admission application online at <https://goo.gl/Ghkn38>.
- Submit all required documents to Office of Admissions, 615 City Park Avenue, New Orleans, LA 70119:
  - Official high school transcript, GED/ HiSET scores, OR all college transcripts (which should be mailed or electronically submitted to the Admissions office)
  - Students who have not taken college English or math must take the Placement Assessment at Delgado (\$15 fee) OR Submit qualifying ACT scores (school code: 1577). For exemption details and to schedule an appointment, visit <https://goo.gl/0zHWWI>.

## 2. Need financial aid? Start now!

It's important to apply early for financial aid. We recommend applying for these forms of aid:

- Federal aid at <https://fafsa.ed.gov/> (School Code: 004626). Please select 2017-2018 FAFSA if you are planning to enroll in Fall 2017, Spring 2018, and/or Summer 2018 Semesters
- Scholarships - <https://goo.gl/U8gc8t>

Then, login to your LoLA account to view the additional documents requested by the Financial Aid office. Your award letter will be posted for you to view in LoLA. Once posted, please review and accept or decline your award. *You must be fully admitted to Delgado and enrolled in an applicable program of study before your financial aid can be applied to your account.*

## 3. Get into classes.

We want to visit with you about your major and help you choose the right classes for your program of study.

- Students who need a Placement Assessment will speak with an advisor after taking the Placement Assessment.
- Students who do not need the Placement Assessment should check <https://goo.gl/N6RrCL> before visiting campus - advisors require an appointment.
  - Before being advised, all students must provide a Placement Assessment score, college transcript, or ACT score with English and math credit.
  - **Transfer students** will meet with an Academic Advisor based on your major and should bring unofficial transcripts to any and all advising sessions for proper placement and prerequisite overrides.
- Register for classes online through LoLA after being advised at <https://goo.gl/uytbb>.
- Secure classes - Fall 2017 tuition and fees are due August 6 by 12 noon.
  - Pay in person (cash, check or money order) or online through LoLA at <https://goo.gl/uytbb> with credit or debit card only.
  - Use the payment plan online through LoLA at <https://goo.gl/uytbb> with credit or debit card only.
  - Use financial aid. If awarded, your authorized financial aid will be applied directly to your account balance. You are responsible for any remaining balance. View your Authorized Aid through LoLA by clicking on Account Balance by Term.

## 4. Prepare for your first day of school.

- Taking online classes? Log on to Canvas, our online classroom.
- Purchase books at the campus bookstore with your printed schedule. *Bookstore vouchers are only available for a limited time for students who have authorized aid on their account.*
- Download the free Delgado App to access email, Canvas (online classroom), and many other resources.
- Make your refund selection at [refundselection.com](http://refundselection.com). Personal codes are received in the bright green envelop through the mail between the first and 14th day of school.
