

DELGADO BASEBALL PLAYERS SHINE ON FIRST DISTRICT AMERICAN LEGION TEAM

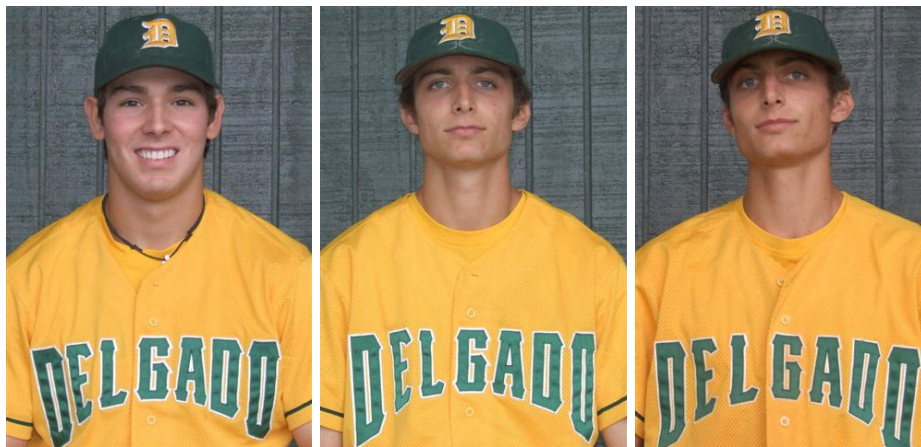
Three current Delgado baseball players have helped lead their First District American Legion team to an undefeated regular season plus a second place finish in the 6-team Southeast Regional Tournament.

Stephen Lukinovich along with Cory and Chad Guidry have all played important roles for the Jesuit based Retif Oil team. Retif was the defending state champion. Lukinovich, who appeared mainly as a pitcher for the Dolphins, had only seven at bats with two hits during his first season at Delgado. However, during legion play, he not only pitched, but also was used as a designed hitter and finished with a .567 batting average, the top of the team. Lukinovich also performed well on the mound for Retif.

Cory Guidry, who finished with a .344 batting average with the Dolphins, had 12 hits in 10 legion games and finished with a .375 average.

Brother Chad, who was injured and did not play this season at Delgado, had 22 at bats in 6 games, got 9 hits, and finished with a .409 average. In an elimination game of the Southeast Regional Tournament in Poncahtoula, Chad had a grand slam against the Brother Martin High School-based Peake BMW team, which went on to win the 2009 American Legion State championship in Crowley this past week.
