



## DELGADO BASEBALL ANNOUNCES 2009-2010 RECRUITING CLASS

The Delgado Community College Baseball office is pleased to announce its 2009-2010 recruiting class. The newest Dolphins will begin classes and workouts this fall. The following student-athletes have signed an NJCAA National Letter of Intent to begin the collegiate careers at Delgado.

Nathan Fury is a right-handed pitcher and infielder who joins the Dolphins after a stellar performance for Rummel High School during his senior season. He earned All-State, All-Metro and All-District honors after following his senior year with the Raiders. Tyler Johns is another member of Coach David Baudry's 2009 Rummel Raider squad to join the Dolphins next season. Johns is a right-handed pitcher/outfielder who was also selected to the '09 All-District team following his senior year with the Raiders. Ryan Pursell joins the Dolphins as a left-handed pitcher and outfielder from Archbishop Rummel High School. Pursell was selected to the 10-5A All-District team as an outfielder following both his junior and senior seasons. During his junior year, Ryan led the team in hitting. Kevin Williams is a right-handed middle infielder who recently completed his senior season at Corona High School, where he posted a .329 batting average for the Panthers. Ryan Williams joins the Delgado team as a right-handed third baseman and outfielder from Prosper High School in Prosper, Texas.

The following players will be transferring to Delgado after beginning their collegiate careers elsewhere. Joey Cesario is a right-handed catcher/utility that bats as a lefty. He graduated from Victor J. Andrew High School in Chicago, Illinois. Prior to hurricane Katrina, he attended Jesuit High School in New Orleans. After graduating in 2008, Cesario attended the University of Houston. Joey's older brother Jimmy was a member of Delgado's 2005 squad prior to transferring to the University of Houston. Scott Fabre transfers to Delgado after a stint at Southeastern Louisiana University. He is a right-handed outfielder who graduated in 2008 from Archbishop Shaw High School, where he played under Coach Doug Faust. Donnie White transfers to Delgado to join the Dolphins after spending the 2009 season with the University of New Orleans Privateers. White is a right-handed outfielder who attended Dutchtown High School prior to graduating in 2008. Delgado will hold try-outs later this summer for those interested in walking on the team.
