



DELGADO FUNDRAISER IS BEST SOLUTION FOR JAZZ FEST 1ST WEEKEND PARKING

Park and walk. Park and bike. Park and bus. Park and dance, if you want. Any way you do it, it's inexpensive and easy to get from Delgado Community College to the Fair Grounds for the Jazz and Heritage Festival weekends. When you take advantage of Delgado's Jazz Fest Weekend Parking fundraiser, you can forego the hassles of street parking and devote your full energy to the great food, music and fun of the fest.

Parking at Delgado's City Park Campus, located at 615 City Park Avenue, benefits a great cause and is easy, economical, safe and secure. Just \$15 per vehicle, per day provides for a designated space in a well-lighted, on-campus parking lot with 24-hour Campus Police security. The lot will be open for incoming vehicles 10 a.m. – 6 p.m. on Saturday, April 25 and Sunday, April 26.

Proceeds from the first weekend of Jazz Fest parking fees will benefit the Delgado Alumni Association, funding scholarships and a gift to the college.

Delgado is just about a 15-minute walk from the Sauvage Pedestrian Entrance to the Jazz and Heritage Festival, easily traversed by foot or bike.

As well, the Regional Transit Authority (RTA) # 91 Jackson/Esplanade bus line, which will provide enhanced service and extended hours during Jazz Fest, can take you directly from Delgado to just a couple of short blocks from the festival entrance for only \$1.25 per person.
