



## LTC JEFFERSON CAMPUS OFFERS INSURANCE ADJUSTER PRE-LICENSING COURSE

Louisiana Technical College Region 1 is offering an exciting new course opportunity, Insurance Adjuster Pre-Licensing, which is designed to prepare a student to successfully take the Louisiana State Personal Lines Licensing Exam by imparting basic knowledge of insurance policies, coverages and concepts.

The classes will be held May 4-27, twice per week on Mondays and Wednesdays, 4:30 – 8:30 p.m. at the LTC Jefferson Campus (5200 Blair Drive, Metairie, La.).

The cost of course tuition is \$250, and the book cost is \$50. Deadline for registration is the first day of class, May 4, 2009.

The 32-hour pre-licensing course is supervised classroom instruction. Students are given practice tests designed to comply with the state test outline for the Personal Lines licensing test.

This course is primarily for students planning to take the licensing examination for Personal Lines adjuster licensing, but also meets the needs and interests of many students as a refresher course in insurance concepts, a course for upgrading insurance knowledge, and a course that provides students with a general "feel" for the subject of insurance adjusting.

Upon completion of the class, a student will be prepared to take the state licensing examination given by Thomson Prometric, a vendor of the Louisiana Department of Insurance (LDI).
