

## DELGADO RAD TECH MAINTAINS 100 PERCENT CERTIFICATION EXAM PASSING RATE

All of Delgado's recent Radiation Therapy graduates have attained the status of "certified" with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists based upon performance on the recently administered ARRT certification examination.

The mean scaled score for the class exceeded the national average by 2.3 points. Delgado's maintenance of a 100 percentage passing rate also outshone once again the percentage passing rate across the country, which was 88 percent.
