

## DELGADO BASEBALL HEAD COACH JOE SCHEUERMANN CELEBRATES 600<sup>TH</sup> WIN

The Delgado Dolphins' game versus Pensacola, Fla., on Friday, March 6, 2009, was more than just another impressive day of baseball for the tenacious team; the 7-1 victory also gave Dolphin Head Coach Joe Scheuermann, now in his 19<sup>th</sup> season, his 600<sup>th</sup> win at Delgado Community College.

Joe Scheuermann is son of the late Louis "Rags" Scheuermann, who started the Delgado baseball program in 1973 and brought the Dolphins to their first Junior College World Series in 1985. Joe took the program over from his dad in the 1990s to continue in his illustrious footsteps and establish his own impressive success. Bringing things full circle, in fact, Joe Scheuermann led the Dolphins to a 6-5 victory over Jefferson College in 2007 to clinch the South Central District Tournament and earn the team a spot in the Junior College World Series for the first time since his father had done so 22 years earlier.

Recognizing his tremendous contributions to the sport, the American Baseball Coaches Association and Diamond Baseball also named Joe Scheuermann Regional Coach of the Year for the 2008 season.

Congratulations to Coach Joe Scheuermann for his milestone accomplishment, which is no doubt just one of many more wins to come.
