Delgado Community College is now accepting applications for its Summer 2009 Non-Credit Course Session, which began June 1, 2009 (many classes start later, including several sections starting in July). Registration is conducted up to five days before the start of the first class (which varies by course; check course schedule for details).

A variety of Summer Non-Credit/Continuing Education courses – including business, legal, computer technology, home and garden, art and design, skill building, food and beverage, sports/health/wellness, dancing, language and Emergency Response Institute – are being offered at Delgado's City Park and West Bank Campuses in New Orleans and Northshore (Covington and Slidell) sites. Classes run the gamut from preparation for professional certification to just plain fun for students seeking just about any type of professional or personal development.
