At the 2009 Phi Theta Kappa International Convention in Grapevine, Texas, on April 16-18, Emily Cosper, advisor of the Omega Nu Chapter of Phi Theta Kappa at Delgado Community College, received the prestigious 2009 Paragon Award For New Advisors.
