

## MUSIC PROFESSOR PERFORMS WITH LEGENDARY PIANIST GEORGE DUKE

Peter Cho, Humanities Department chair and associate professor of Music, performed at two events with legendary pianist George Duke as faculty for the Louis “Satchmo” Armstrong Summer Jazz Camp, for which he has served as instructor for nine years.
