



## HORTICULTURE PROGRAM HOLDS PLANT SALE JUN. 27-28

The Horticulture program will be having its Growth Works Club Two-day Summer Plant Reduction Sale Friday, June 27, 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. and Saturday, June 28, 1 – 4 p.m. at the greenhouse on Delgado's City Park Campus (on Orleans Avenue).

Prices have been reduced (everything \$1-20) in an effort to move out plants that students have grown from cuttings and seed over the past year. PROCEEDS FROM PLANT SALES FUND HORTICULTURE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS.

As a service to anyone who brings in his/her own planter and purchases a plant at the sale, the Horticulture program will pot the purchased plant in the planter at no cost. As well, Program Director Abbate and her students will be on hand to discuss gardening problems, answer questions and provide information on growing any of the plants for sale.

Plants available for sale include house plants (Aloe Vera, Dracaena, Bromeliads, Ivies, Mother-in-Law plant, Philodendron, Schefflera, Wandering Jew, Spider Plant, Rubber Plant and Peace Lily); herbs (Rosemary, Basil, Lemon Thyme, Parsley, Oregano and Lemongrass); and garden plants (Amaryllis, Strawberry Begonia, Rex Begonia, Milkweed, Butterfly Ginger, Oleander, Cassia and Lantana).
