The 55<sup>th</sup> annual Symphony Book Fair, benefiting the Louisiana Philharmonic Orchestra (LPO), will be held May 15-17, 2008, in the first floor of the Delgado City Park Campus Student Life Center.

**Art and Collectibles** – Quality artworks, framed and unframed, large and small, including some original oils, pastels and watercolors; posters and prints, some signed and numbered; many works feature Mardi Gras, Jazz Fest and other local themes; also vintage postcards for the avid collector, puzzles and board games for the beginner to the advanced.
