ATTENDANCE IS MANDATORY FOR STUDENTS PLANNING TO ENROLL IN PRACTICUM FOR SPRING 2024.


WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND?

 - CDYC 273 (Curriculum & Teaching Materials)
- Cannot be enrolled in more than two (2) courses with Practicum.
- Cannot be enrolled in any classes during the hours of 8 a.m. 3 p.m.
- Departmental permission is required for all applicants.
