

Life Experience Credit

Students Currently enrolled in the Criminal Justice Program at Delgado Community College for with at least 12 credit hours, including CRJU 105, Introduction to Criminal Justice System and meet any and or all the Required Qualifications listed may apply for Life Experience Credit.

Qualifying Criminal Justice Courses you can use POST an or experience in lieu of attending these class!

CRJU 101 - Introduction to Policing, 3 lecture hours, no lab hours, 3 credit hours

CRJU 103 - Introduction to Corrections, 3 lecture hours, no lab hours, 3 credit hours

CRJU 298 - Criminal Justice Practicum, 2 lecture hours, 5 lab hours, 3 credit hours Research and field work, under staff supervision, in student's area of concentration.

Required Qualification for each listed course

CRJU 101 – Introduction to Policing you MUST HAVE:

Level 1 - Certification for Basic Law Enforcement Peace Officers

The student will complete a training course with minimum hours for full certification. Level 1 certification requires that the student meet the POST requirements for firearm certification.

CRJU 103 – Introduction to Corrections you MUST HAVE:

Level 2 - Certification for Basic Correctional Peace Officer

The student will complete a training course with a minimum of 249 hours and is limited to those peace officers whose duties are the care, custody, and control of inmates. The training course consists of the core curriculum plus a sufficient number of hours to obtain POST certification. POST Firearm certification for Level 2 students is required. (eff. in 2001) OR,

Level 3 - Certification for Jailer Training Officers

The student will complete a training course with a minimum of 92 hours and is limited to those correctional officers whose duties are the care, custody, and control of inmates. This course consists of the core correctional officer curriculum. POST Firearm certification for Level 3 students is not required.

CRJU 298 - Criminal Justice Practicum you MUST HAVE:

Verifiable documentation that you are currently working in the field of law enforcement or corrections for a minimum of one year.
