CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT PROGRAM INFORMATION CHECKLIST & SUPPLY LIST

Program Requirements:

- You must be at least 16 years old.
- You must have a High School Diploma, high school equivalency or a passing score on the ability to Benefit Exam.
- You must be able to preform the Technical Standards of the program.
- You must pass a Statewide Criminal Background Check which includes a check of the National Sex Offenders Public Registry.
- The Statewide Criminal Background Check which includes a check of the National Sex Offenders Public Registry must be completed and receive prior to admission into the program.

A trainee is not eligible to participate in the program if convicted or found guilty by a court of law of the following:

- i. Abusing , neglecting, or mistreating the elderly, or infirm as defined by R. S. 40:2009.20
- ii. Misappropriating a resident's property or
- iii. Has had a finding of abuse , neglect, mistreatment, or misappropriation of resident's property , placed on the Nurse Aide or the Direct Service Worker Registry

Program Check list:

- Complete an online Delgado Community College Admissions Application if you are not currently a Delgado student. You will be assigned a LoLA ID#.
- Review the Technical Standards Form for the CNA program.
- Register for the CNA course online.
- Attend class on Day 1 for further instructions.

General Course Information:

- The CNA course is an eight-week course. There are two eight-week sessions each semester except for the summer semester, and the course is held at the City Park Main Campus, 615 City park Building 14, New Orleans , LA 70119.
- On the first day of the course, you will receive information regarding the necessary Health Screenings, Technical Standards, Statewide Criminal Background Check, and Urine Drug Screening.
- Costs associated with program total \$475 plus tuition and fees. Refer to CNA Supply list for cost breakdown.

- Financial Aid may be available if your major is Pre-Practical Nursing, and you also enroll in either HESC 109 Nutrition or BIOL. 161/163 Anatomy & Physiology.
- Upon completion of the course, you must pass both a written and skills test at an approved State Testing Center(Louisiana Department of Health) in order to be placed on the Louisiana Nurse Aide Registry List.
