

The curriculum plan for the 2nd semester, Level II, includes five courses: NURS125 (Nursing II); NURS 129 (Special Populations I); NURS 127 (Pharmacology II); PSYC 127 (General Psychology); and BIOL 211 (Microbiology). All five must be completed before enrolling in the 3rd semester nursing courses. Students who enroll concurrently in NURS 125 (Nursing II) and NURS 129 (Special Populations I) must enroll in courses taught by the same faculty team. Four teams are planned for Fall 2021. Registration for Nursing 125 (Nursing II), Nursing 129 (Special Populations I) and NURS 127 (Pharmacology II) is **May 28 0900**. There are 2 online Pharmacology II sections and one live/or virtual session. Students who have previously registered for a clinical nursing course (*Previously unsuccessful*) **must register for a different team/faculty member** unless given permission to do so by the level coordinator.

Level 2 is complex with the 2-3 courses being offered. Please read the entire document before you register.

Students who plan to enroll **part time** may elect to enroll in a combination of courses with the understanding that there are pre and co-requisites that must be considered.

- NURS 127, **Pharmacology II** requires Nursing 113 and Pharm I as a prerequisite.
- NURS 129, **Special Populations I** requires PSYC 127, General Psychology and NURS 127, Pharmacology II as a pre or co-requisites.
- NURS 125, **Nursing II** requires Pharm II as pre or co-requisite.

Nursing 129 (Special Populations I) has limited clinical facilities accepting students. The current locations are River Oaks Hospital in Harahan, St. Charles Behavioral Health Unit in Luling and Beacon Behavioral Center in New Orleans East, and Northlake Behavioral Health. All Nursing 129 clinicals are an 8-hour day/week and additional virtual time of 4 hours to compose the 12 hour/week requirement. NURS 129 faculty will explain this in more detail. **NURS 129 is a three-week experience.**

Nursing 125 (Nursing II) is a fifteen-week experience. When you are in one clinical course, you are not in the other clinical course. Theory goes throughout the entire semester.

The clinical component of Nursing II is considered the ‘Home Base’ for enrolled students and some students will rotate to the Special Populations I clinical as times and locations are available. Students who register for Nursing II sections **312 and 322** and some other students who register for Special Pops I will start their clinical in the Special Populations for the first rotation and then rotate to the Nursing II clinical as their “Home Base” for the remainder of the semester. **Only students** who register in Nursing II sections **312 & 322** should email Ms. Pat Smart, Level II Coordinator, at psmart@dcc.edu to select their Nursing II clinical section preference from the team you are on. Students in Section 312 will select an instructor on team 2; students in Section 322 will select a clinical instructor on team 4. These sections will be filled on a first email, first serve basis. Use the following registration tables to register for corresponding sections of the nursing courses.

Students who register for a clinical with a Nursing II instructor that is doing their own Special Pops I clinical must register for the corresponding CRN for that same clinical instructor for Special Pops I. If you do not need both Special Pops I and Nursing II please do not register for sections where the same Nursing II instructor is listed for Special Pops I. **Follow the grid all the way across. If students register for the wrong CRNs they will be placed in the correct section the first week of class. Please follow these instructions.**

All students will be oriented to Level II on August 16th. The time and way it will be delivered is TBA.

During week one, you will have a Med Competency Exam. You have to renew/pay for your exam-soft account for the semester in order to take the math Competency exam. (If you took Pharm II during the summer and paid for ExamSoft, you do not have to pay as the summer payment includes the fall semester.) This will include things you learned in Pharm 1 and Nursing 1. Plan for participation in class & clinical time during week one of the semester, from 8am-4:30 pm, even if you have evening or weekend clinical. The calendar for the first two weeks will be posted on the Canvas site the week before classes start. You will receive instructions from your clinical instructor when to wear the clinical uniform and when you will be in the building for lab time.

Sections will be available to drop/add until August 17.

There will be mandatory sessions for Students in Nsg 125 and 129 to attend during the first week. The exact dates and time will be announced as it gets closer to August and the college makes decisions for the fall.
