**During the summer, NURS 129 and NURS 127 are offered**

The curriculum plan for the 2nd semester, Level II, includes five courses: NURS125 (Nursing II); NURS 129 (Special Populations I); NURS 127 (Pharmacology II); PSYC 127 (General Psychology); and BIOL 211 (Microbiology). All five must be completed before enrolling in the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester nursing courses.

Students who plan to enroll **this summer** may elect to enroll in a combination of courses with the understanding that there are pre and co-requisites that must be considered.

- NURS 127, **Pharmacology II** requires Nursing 113 and Pharm I as a prerequisite.
- NURS 129, **Special Populations I** requires PSYC 127, General Psychology and NURS 127, Pharmacology II as a pre or co-requisites.

Registration for Nursing 129 (Special Populations I) and NURS 127 (Pharmacology II) is May 20 at 0900. There are only online Pharmacology II sections. There are 3 sections for Pharm for a total of 90 spots. **Testing for Pharm 2 is being planned to take place in the building on Monday afternoons. Pharm 2 exams in the building will be held on June 21, July 12 at 1300 and 1400 and the final is July 22 at 0900.**

Students who have previously registered for a clinical nursing course (*Previously unsuccessful*) **must register for a different team/faculty member** unless given permission to do so by the level coordinator.

Nursing 129 (Special Populations I) has limited clinical facilities accepting students. The current locations are River Oaks Hospital in Harahan, St. Charles Behavioral Health Unit in Luling and Northlake Behavioral Health on the northshore. All Nursing 129 clinicals are an 8-hour day/week and additional virtual time to compose the 12 hour/week requirement. NURS 129 faculty will explain this in more detail. **NURS 129 is a three-week experience.** There are 56 spots for Nsg 129. **Classes will be held virtually via Zoom on Mondays from 0900 -1100.**

**Dr. Hoppe, Mrs. Serpas, and Ms. Mose will have clinical on Tuesday/Wednesday in person 0730-1530. Thursday will be virtual clinical: Tuesday section will be 0900--1100; Wednesday section will be 1200-1400.**

**Ms. Cloud will have clinical on Tuesday/Thursday in person 0730-1530. Wednesday will be virtual clinical: Tuesday section will be 0900-1100; Thursday section will be 1200-1400.**

**Classes will be virtual, but testing is planned to be in the building. Nursing 129 will have class Monday mornings from 0900-1100.**

**There is NO remote testing this summer.**

**All students will be oriented to Level II on Monday 6/7 at 0900. This will be a Zoom, virtual orientation, and the link will be posted on the Canvas site. On 6/7, class will be from 1000-1200 and Clinical orientation will be from 1300-1500. This is a **mandatory all day** event you are responsible to participate in for Nsg 129.**

**If you register for this course-YOU must be available from 9-3pm on June 7<sup>th</sup> and available from 9-12 on 7/19. You will take the Kaplan exam 7/19, following exam 2.**

**You will take a Med Competency Exam, on Monday, 6/14 at 1300. You have to renew/pay for your exam-soft account for the semester in order to take the math Competency exam.** This will include things you learned in Pharm 1 and Nursing 1.

**Nursing 129 will have class Monday mornings from 0900-1100. Exam 1 for Nsg 129 is 6/28 at 0830. Exam 2 for Nsg 129 is July 19 at 0900, and the Kaplan Test will be given at 11 am. The final exam is July 26, starting at 0900.**

**The last day to drop with a W is June 14<sup>th</sup>-Census Day.**
