Complete the online application. Link is on the RN Program page of the Delgado Nursing website page. All applicants, must complete a Kaplan Pre-Nursing Exam through the Delgado Community College Testing Center prior to submitting their online application.

Please put your name and LoLA number on each document prior to scanning

- Curriculum Self-Assessment Page All students must have English 101, English 102, College level Math (Math 120 or a higher course), Human Anatomy and Physiology (BIOL 251, BIOL 253, BIOL 252, BIOL 254), Microbiology (BIOL 210 or 211), General Psychology 127, and either 3 credit hours in Fine Arts or Humanities Elective with a grade of "C" or higher to be eligible for Spring or Fall admission. Summer admission also requires completion of a 2nd College level Math and the remaining Fine Arts or Humanities.
- Students who have attended another Nursing Program within the last 5 years, must submit a Transfer Reference Form which must be completed and signed by the Dean of the Nursing program previously attended.
- Course descriptions for any Clinical Nursing or Pharmacology courses taken at another college/university for which you are requesting transfer credit.

Send official college transcripts of **all** colleges attended outside of Delgado Community College to delgadoadmissions@dcc.edu or Delgado Community College, Office of Admissions, 615 City Park Avenue, New Orleans, LA, 70119

If you have attended a college that is part of the LCTCS (BPCC, BRCC, CLTCC, LDCC, FTCC, NTCC, NCC, NLTC, RPCC, SLCC, SOWELA), you must request your transcript to be downloaded into your LoLA account if you have not already done so. Go to the Delgado home page at www.dcc.edu, click on Admissions, click on Forms, under General, click on LCTCS Transcript Download Request.
