Plan your route

- Know where, how, and with whom you're going.
- Leave with a full tank of gas and plan that it could take 4 times longer than usual with contraflow.

Use City-Assisted Evacuation if you can't evacuate on your own

- During a mandatory evacuation, go to one of 17 evacuspots. 5 have extra spots for seniors.
- If you can't get to an evacuspot because of medical needs, you might be eligible to be picked up from your home. Call 311.
- Buses will take you to a shelter outside the area and will bring you back when it's safe.
- Bring only 1 carry-on sized bag per person.
- Pets should have an ID collar, leash, medications, and a carrier.
- Masks will be provided.
