 Income (If you are a dependent, parent information is also required):


- Federal Tax Return: 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ or IRS Tax Return Transcript. (Note: It is recommended you use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool option when completing the FAFSA. This will ensure the information is accurate and limit the chance of being selected for verification).
- W2 form(s) if you worked but were not required to file a tax return.
- Social Security number
- Alien registration number (if applicable)
- Untaxed income such as child support received, veterans non-education benefits, workers compensation.

#### 1. Create FSA ID

An FSA ID serves as your official legal signature. Use your ID to sign the FAFSA and access other educational websites.



### 2. Complete FAFSA

Visit our Enrollment Lab at the City Park Campus, Building 10, Room 134 on Tuesday & Thursday, 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. for help. Delgado's FAFSA school code is 004626.



# 3. Check Eligibility

Check your "Fin Aid Status" in LoLA to see if you have unmet requirements. Document review takes up to 15 business days.



# 4. Accept Award

Check "Award for Aid Year" in LoLA. If you accept loans, complete a Master Promissory Note & Loan Entrance Counseling at studentloans.gov.



#### 5. Select Refund

Make REFUND CHOICE through LoLA.



#### 6. Check Authorized Aid

A note that you have Authorized Aid appears on "Award for Aid Year." To see Authorized Aid, check "Account Detail for Term" in LoLA. Negative dollar amount = secured classes.



#### 7. Check Bookstore Credit

Check the Student ID Card portal to see if you are eligible. Credit is only available for a limited time at the beginning of each semester.



#### 8. Disbursements Processed

The process of applying funds to a student's account to cover tuition, fees, and books (if applicable) begins.



# 9. Refund Process Begins

Once funds disburse, the refund process can take about 14 days from the date the credit posted.
