**FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID:** You may be eligible for federal grants or loans. Get started TODAY! Schedule one-on-one, live FAFSA assistance and financial counseling at [mosaiec.org/coaching](http://mosaiec.org/coaching). Complete the Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) at [fafsa.ed.gov](http://fafsa.ed.gov). Delgado's school code is 004626. You will need these documents:

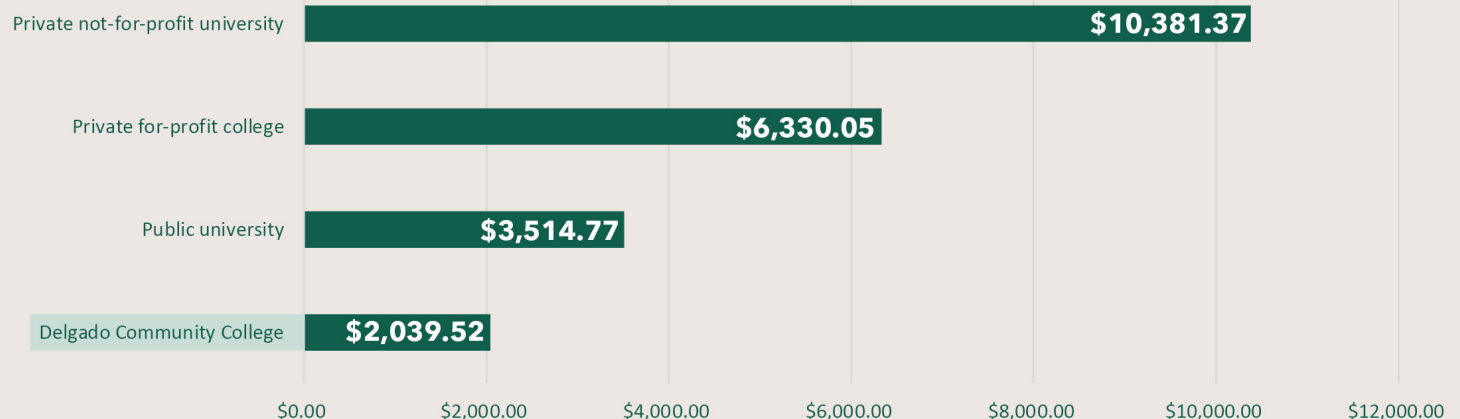
- Income (If you are a dependent, parent information is also required):
- Federal Tax Return: 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ or IRS Tax Return Transcript. (Note: It is recommended you use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool option when completing the FAFSA. This will ensure the information is accurate and limit the chance of being selected for verification).
- W2 form(s) if you worked but were not required to file a tax return.
- Social Security number
- Alien registration number (if applicable)
- Untaxed income such as child support received, veterans non-education benefits, workers compensation.

### AVERAGE TUITION & FEES PER SEMESTER



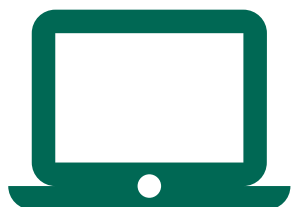

Schedule one-on-one, live FAFSA assistance and financial counseling at [mosaiec.org/coaching](http://mosaiec.org/coaching).

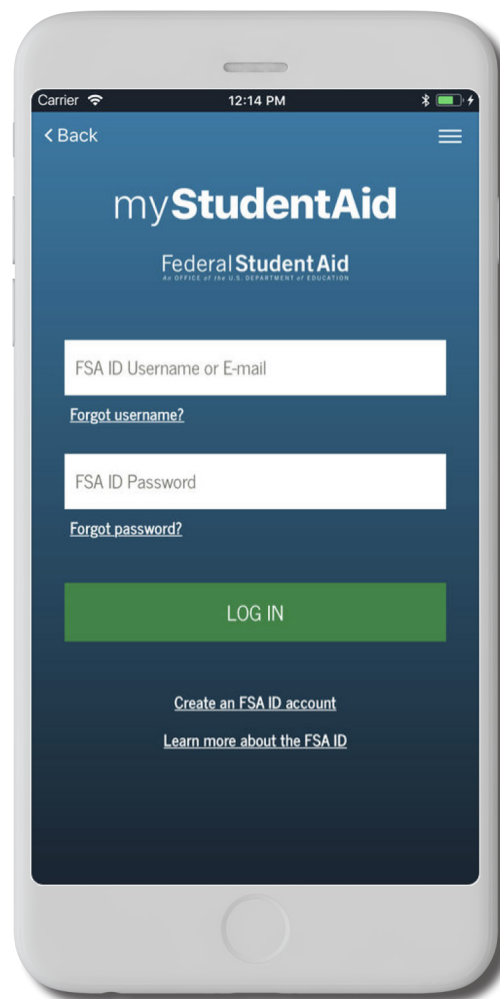
## 2. Check Eligibility
